About a mile and a half from the village of Hollywood, the river Liffey forms the celebrated and picturesque waterfall called Polafouca, or Demons Hole, consisting of three successive falls about 120 feet in height. The chasm is only 40 feet wide and is skirted on each side by 51 perpendicular & masses of rock; when the river is swollen by heavy rains the water rushes down with tumultuous impetuosity into a circular basin of the rock worn quite smooth and of great depth. (From this the fall takes its name). It then dashes thro' narrow openings in the rocks, and forms two more falls, the lowest being about 80 feet high. The late Earl of Miltown took a lively interest in this picturesque spot, which he much improved by planting one side of the glen, making walks and erecting rustic 53 buildings in various places, besides a banqueting room 40 feet long by 20 wide from which there is a delightful view of the falls and bridge with the perpendicular rocks partly planted and the upper moss seat appearing thro' the arch of the bridge. Coll. Aylmer is now the proprietor and has appointed a person to take proper care of it, by (from) whom accommodation can be prepared (obtained. H.F.) for the numerous visitors that resort thither from Dublin 55 and elsewhere. Seats have been placed in the most advantageous situations for obtaining different views of the fall, a rustic seat above the head of the fall commands an excellent view of the cataract, bridge, lower 56 rustic seat and the banqueting hall, with the windings of the river.

Immediately over the basin on the line of the new Turnpike road from Blessington to Saltinglass, is a picturesque bridge of one pointed arch springing from rock 57 to rock built in antique style. The span of the arch is 4 feet (7 40. H.F.), the altitude of the chord above the upper fall is 47 feet, the height of the key stone above the bed of the river is 150 feet.
