Compact Growth - Housing - Population Growth

Submission

Housing could be developed on land around the Avon ri or in the Manor Kilbride Road, at the bottom of Red Lane. The site opposite dunnes stores/ in Downshire Park could be used for housing/ cinema/swimming pool.

Topic

Regeneration of Communities & Places - Healthy Placemaking - Urban Design - Opportunity Sites in Blessington

The Downshire Hotel needs to be redeveloped or renovated. Aswell as having tourist accommodation it could house restaurants/bar/swimming pool. Locals could use facilities during the quiet month's but to be honest I think a hotel is this area would do fantastically all year around, providing leisure facilities, conference facilities, wedding/ party facilities etc.

Heritage – Biodiversity- Green infrastructure- Climate Action- Energy **Submission**

The new walk way to glending forest is nearly ready to be open. But perhaps the car park, on the Blessington to Naas Road, could be upgraded to ensure it doesn't ice over in the cold weather.

The old ulster bank building should be used in the community. Perhaps luxury accommodation or a community meeting place could be put in.

Topic

Infrastructure - Sustainable Movement - Transportation **Submission**

We need access to more frequent buses. Would it be possible to have a 65 that doesn't go around the square in Tallaght, but instead stays on the n81 and continues straight into dublin Town. We need more frequent buses into town. We need more bus stops for the local 885 and local link buses. There's only one stop in the middle of the town but a stop outside Downshire Park/ burgage Manor/ deer park would be great.

More street lights around the town, or can get a little dark on the ring road from aldi to deer park and from the KWETB to Burgage Manor.

Street lights are needed on the n81 to Tallaght if people of going to cycle/ walk. It's too dark. Open the new ring road from roadstone to Kelly's garage.

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
