1 Notice of motion in the name of Cllr. Lourda Scott (proposer) and supported by Cllr. Grace McManus, Cllr. Mags Crean, Cllr. Jodie Neary, Cllr. Anne Ferris and Cllr. Dermot O'Brien (4th June 2021) (deferred from Meeting of 5th July 2021)

'Wicklow County Council acknowledges the need for a new national maternity hospital (NMH) to provide healthcare in the Greater Dublin Area, including County Wicklow.

Wicklow County Council notes the lack of legal clarity regarding the ownership and management of the hospital, and also acknowledges the concerns regarding the employment rights for those who will work in the hospital, many of whom who live in Wicklow.

Wicklow County Council agrees to write to the Minister for Health to call for the proposed new publicly-funded NMH to be constructed on land owned by the State; and that, to guarantee it's secular ethos, the new facility be fully owned and governed by the State. If passed, it is agreed that this motion is circulated to all Local Authorities'.
