"Discretionary Funding Support for Memorial space with Irish Proclamation Stone Centrepiece

Motion:

That this Municipal District supports the allocation of discretionary funding towards the creation of a Space in Arklow, with its centrepiece being a stone-carved reproduction of the 1916 Proclamation of the Irish Republic, in keeping with similar commemorative features already established across County Wicklow.

Furthermore, that this initiative be expanded in scope to include Avoca and Aughrim, with the vision of establishing a network of reflection spaces across the district. These spaces will honour Ireland's historical legacy, promote civic pride and provide peaceful, inclusive public places for remembrance and community engagement"

Community Empowerment & Inclusion Fund (Rolling Annual Programme)

Support Scheme for Individuals Representing the district at High-Level Extracurricular Activities

Motion:

This scheme would provide financial support to help with costs.

Applications would be invited through a simple process, reviewed on a rolling basis or twice annually and awarded based on merit, impact and the ambassadorial role played by the individual in promoting Arklow and the district.

This initiative recognises the commitment, discipline and excellence of those who pursue extracurricular success and seeks to remove financial barriers to participation and progression, while also promoting civic pride and positive role models for our younger generation.
