



ACTIVE TRAVEL SCHEME (SECTION 38) ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994
Safe Routes to School Treatment and Traffic Calming Scheme
Non- Statutory Public Consultation, Kilmacanogue, Co. Wicklow

Wicklow County Council proposes to undertake construction of a new school zone and traffic calming measures for pedestrian safety improvements in Kilmacanogue, Co. Wicklow. These designs have been developed based on best practice and guidance to address safety issues raised by Kilmacanogue NS who applied to the Safe Routes to School programme.

Wicklow County Council is responsible for the procurement and coordination for the design and implementation of the schemes with the Safe Routes to School treatments approved by the National Transport Authority (NTA).

The proposed scheme will consist of traffic calming measures on sections of Rockfield Park and the R755 including footpath renewal, junction tightening, additional and upgraded crossing points, bollards to restrict illegal parking, colour surface contrasting, all to highlight the presence of the school and create a safer environment. The traffic calming works proposed are part of the Safe Routes to School programme, developed in partnership with the NTA and Green Schools in 2021, following the application by the school.

The aim of the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) interventions is to highlight the presence of schools, encourage lower speeds and more attentive driver behaviour. Primarily this will be achieved through signage and road markings, pedestrian crossing upgrades as traffic calming interventions which have been shown in trials to reduce excessive speeds.

It is intended to undertake the proposed works between Q3 – Q4 of 2026.

The Council will consider any submissions or observations made in writing regarding the proposal. Submissions should be lodged with the Active Travel Team, Arklow MD District Office, Castle Park, Arklow, Y14 FX63 or by email to activetravel@wicklowcoco.ie to be received by 5pm on Wednesday 8th of July 2026.

Please note that submissions, including names of those making comments, submitted to the Council regarding this process may form part of the report for recording and publication of the decision following the outcome of the consultation process. The report shall be circulated to the elected members. Accordingly, they may also appear in the public domain.
