Wicklow County Council Arts Office established the Artist Award Scheme in 2013. It is one of a number of schemes designed to support artists, arts participation and art form development in County Wicklow.





This scheme forms part of a wider set of actions initiated and developed by Wicklow County Council directed at supporting quality practice and public participation in the arts throughout the county

Purpose of the Scheme

- ➔ Support the development and creation of **virtual, digital and physical practice and methodologies**
- ➔ Support **reflective ways of thinking** and developing work which includes the **creation of new local, national and/or international collaboration**, reaching across borders tangible and imaginary
- ➔ Support the creation of **new works** in all art forms that respond to **times of social change**, **researches new ideas, questions themes or insights** and **looks to the future**

Who is eligible

- ➔ The Artist Awards Scheme is open to **artists at all stages** of their careers that **reside in or are native to County Wicklow**.
- ➔ Professional artists working in any art forms, discipline or genre including; **film, music, visual arts, theatre, dance, literature, architecture, animation, performance, circus, traditional arts, film, music and drama**, are eligible to apply to this scheme.

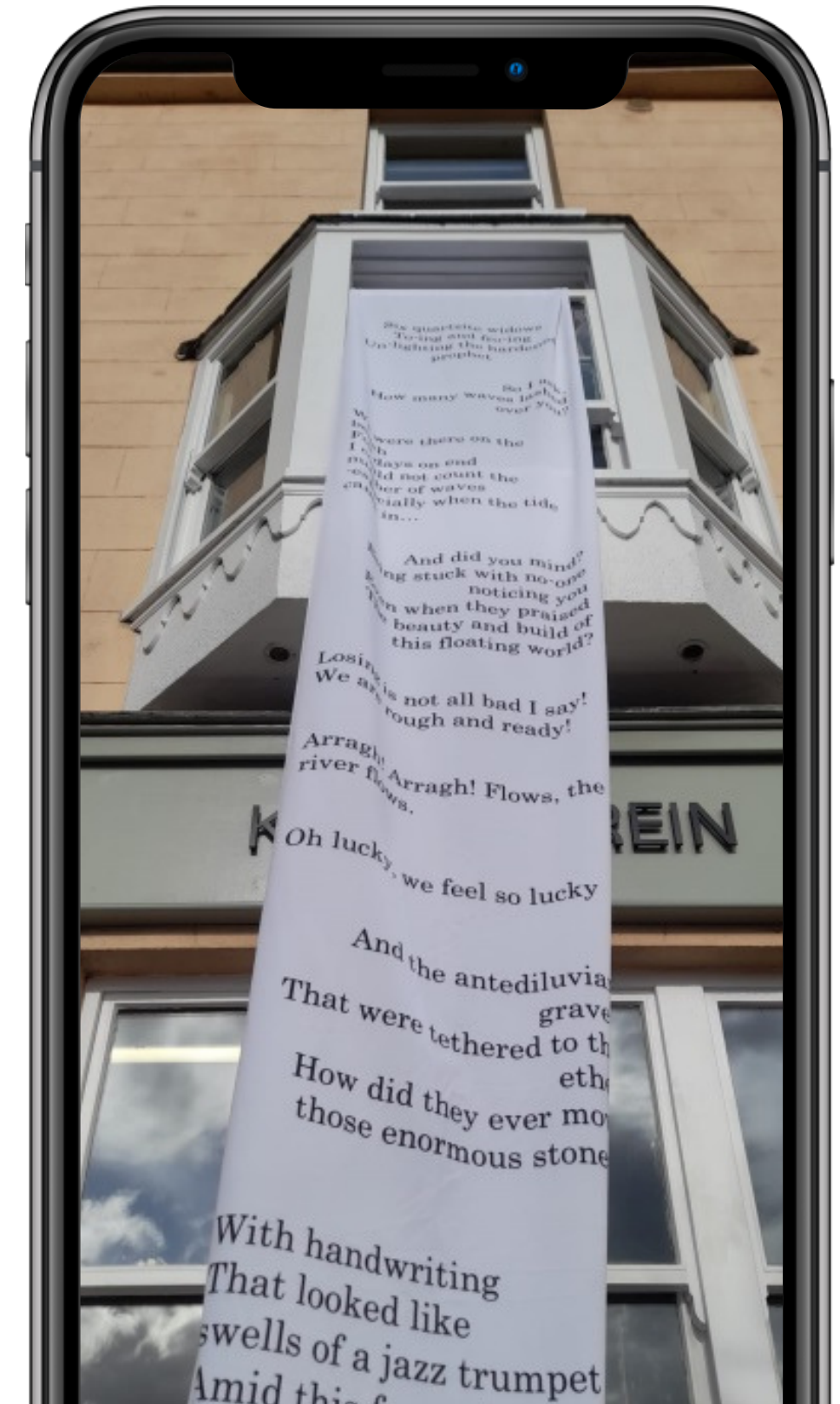
