"In light of ongoing maintenance issues raised regarding Darcy's Park, Wicklow County Council carry out a formal inspection of the park and its infrastructure; seek clarification from SISPAR or relevant entity, on the maintenance regime, inspection schedules and budgets allocated to the park, ensure that necessary repairs, vegetation management (including invasive species removal) and replacement planting are undertaken without delay."
 - (b) Motion in the names of Councillors L. Scott and S. Stokes:
"With recent funding allocation unsuccessful for Dr. Ryan Park, a meeting is sought with the Director of Climate, Environment, Recreation and Amenity to discuss reconvening the Dr Ryan Park Committee and the plans for future development of the parklands."



- (c) Motion in the names of Councillors M. Barry, L. Fenelon Gaskin, O. Finn, T. Fortune, L. Scott and S. Stokes:
"That the Councillors of the Greystones Municipal District request this office to write to the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage to express our concerns regarding the Call for Sites process.

We note that 76 hectares of land in this district is already zoned, with active planning permission on most of this land. We ask the Minister to confirm whether he will ensure this land is developed before further land is zoned, or, if further land is to be zoned, whether he will put in place whatever measures are necessary to ensure that this pre-existing zoned land, and land with planning permission, is delivered, along with all associated community gain, before other sites identified through the "Call for Sites" process are commenced.

We further note that the most recent Local Area Plan for this district zoned 36 hectares of land. We ask what the Department is doing to ensure this land is delivered in a timely fashion and is not shelved in favour of new sites being zoned under the "Call for Sites" process.

We also require a commitment that the infrastructure needed to support this scale of housing development, including school places, healthcare facilities, additional DART capacity, playing facilities, community resource centres and other social infrastructure, will be delivered at the same pace as the housing itself, to ensure the area does not suffer from excess congestion or shortfalls in these services.

We raise this in light of the current housing crisis, and the need to prioritise delivery of housing and community infrastructure on land already zoned and permitted, rather than continuing to zone new land while existing capacity remains undelivered."
