AT a General Assizes held at Wicklow in and for said county, on Monday the 1st day of August, 1810, the following Presentments were made by the Grand Jury, and fiated by the Court.

- 15 0 0 To Francis W. Greene, John Jackson, and Marks Weeks, to make an embankment and fill between the arch and the hill on the great road from Hacketstown to Dublin, on Downings.
- 5 3 5 To same, to make 5 pipes or gullets, on road from Balinglafs to Wicklow, through Imall, on Spynans.
- 10 0 0 To Francis Wm. Greene, Denis Finn, and James Doran, to make a foot bridge on road from Rathilly to Dublin, through Coolnarrigg.
- 17 0 8 To same, to build two walls adjoining Bridge of Downings, and to repair battlement walls of said bridge on road from Hacketstown to Dublin.
- 6 4 2 To Robert M'Bride and James Coleman, to make three pipes and to repair four pipes on road from Broadford to Dublin—on Woodfield.
- 15 10 2 To Francis William Green, William Murphy, and Simon Laurenson, to fill and gravel over bridge between Ballyroan and Talbotstown, on road from Hacketstown to Dublin.
- 14 0 0 To Francis William Greene, Dennis Finn, and James Doran, to build a wall to the South East end and dash the bridge between the Townlands of Talbotstown and Ballyroan.

- 36 8 4 To the inspector of the gaol of Wicklow, so much paid over the sum allowed for fuel, straw, and other necessaries, from last assizes to the present, for prisoners in said gaol.
- 133 0 0 To contractors, to provide fuel, straw, and other necessaries, from Lent assizes, 1811, to Summer assizes 1811.
- 7 0 0 To same, to provide coals and candles, for gaol-yard, from this assizes to Lent assizes 1811.
- 23 2 7 To William Goodison, for Medicines delivered to the Prisoners in the Gaol of Wicklow.
- 15 0 0 To John Dunkley, Inspector of the Gaol of Baltinglafs, to enable him to provide bedding for said Gaol.
- 2 5 0 To same for Bread delivered to the prisoners in said Gaol, between Summer Assizes 1809 and Spring 1810.
- 2 5 6 To same to provide Bread for said Gaol from Summer Assizes 1810 to Spring 1811.
- 5 10 3 To William Brown, Divisional Clerk, for returning names to divisional meeting of Lower Half Barony of Talbotstown
- 2 18 3 To John Seal, Corporal, and the party with him of the Queen's County Militia, for escorting James Gibbons a prisoner, from Baltinglafs to Wicklow.
