We have no toilets, changing room, no meeting / training facilities indoors, no fresh running water and no electricity. The club has limited boat storage. Apart from basic needs, we have people trying to get changed outdoors in car parks.

Please consider allocating some land to Poulaphouca Paddlers for a club house close to the lake - perhaps the Burgage area. Or perhaps a shared site with other water sports like rowing or a scouts group. The club provide a fantastic and healthy outlet for children, teens and adults of all ages. This club has the potential to grow and thrive with the right base. It would be a really great addition to the local community and and outlet for young and old alike.
