Mullinacuff (Parish) (contd.)

In County of Wicklow & Barony of Shillelagh; Bounded on the North by Carlow Co. & Kilcommon Psh. Co. Wicklow; on the East by Kilcommon and Crosspatrick Pshes; on the South by Carnew Psh. and on the West by Aghold Psh. and Co. Carlow.

Area about 6615 acres 3 pers. Proprietor Earl Fitzwilliam of the Psh. who resides in London. Agent Robert Chaloner Esqre. Coolatin Park. The Psh. is a Rectory and inappropriate cure in the Province of Leinster and diocese of Leighlin. The Rectory is appropriate to the Dean and Chapter of Leighlin & the inappropriate cure forms a benefice.

The East side of the Psh. pretty well cultivated but 20 on the West side there is much bog and rough pasture. There are two flour mills in the Psh., one in T.Ld. Newtown, breast wheel, diameter 12 feet, breadth three and a half feet, capable of grinding 60 Bags of flour per week when well supplied with water which is, however, not the case during the summer months and the other in T.Ld. Ballymulta, five story high & well supplied with water, breast wheel eighteen and a half feet in diameter, four and a half feet broad, capable of grinding 12 & 100 bags of flour per week; a bleach mill and green is close to this latter flour mill. Two good houses are in the Psh., Forttown House and Ballyreheen Ho. both in Ballyreheen Townland, the former occupied by F. Morton Esqre. and the latter by Mrs. Chamney. There is a corn mill in Croneloe T.Ld. The R.C. Chapel is in a grave yard in Kilquiggin T.Ld. About a quarter of a mile East of Chapel is an 21 old stone cross and a little to East of cross is the site of an old Church in old grave yard. In Strathakelly T.Ld. is also the ruin of a Church in an old grave yard. There are eight small raths and one moat scattered through the Psh.
